Purpose of Job

The Sound No 1 is responsible for the maintenance and operation of sound equipment as per the Sound Designer's specification and is responsible for maintaining an accurate and appropriate sound design of the production as specified by the Sound Designer. They are responsible for the management and running of the Sound Department.

Duties and Responsibilities Include

- Responsible for all aspects of the management, supervision and scheduling of members of the Sound team.
- Work collaboratively with other departments to ensure the smooth running of the show.
- To ensure all sound equipment is cleaned and ready for each performance with daily sound check completed to ensure
 equipment is in working order.
- To coordinate the supply of all equipment and consumables required to run the show within budget as approved by the Company/General Manager. Keeping the petty cash documentation up to date.
- To keep sound reference/cue sheets up to date.
- To operate the sound mix for performances as instructed by the Sound Designer.
- Attend rehearsal, technical, dress and understudy rehearsals as required.
- Deal with emergency repairs to sound equipment
- Contribute and adhere to risk assessments.
- Recognise where maintenance work needs to be carried out on equipment outside of the venue and to bring this to the
 attention of the Production/General Manager so this may be scheduled to ensure no show delays.
- Ensure that work materials are kept in a tidy and secured manner.
- Ensure that security, safety and good housekeeping procedures for the department are properly carried out.
- Comply with the Manager's Health and Safety and other policies at all times.
