Purpose of Job

The Video No 2 will assist in the maintenance and operation of AV and projection equipment as per the Video Designer and Head of Video's specification and will assist in maintaining an accurate and appropriate video design of the production as specified by the Video Designer.

Duties and Responsibilities Include

- Deputising for the Video No1 in the management, supervision and scheduling of members of the Video team in the Video No1's absence
- Work collaboratively with other departments, to ensure the smooth running of the show.
- To ensure all AV and projection equipment is cleaned and daily checks completed to ensure equipment is in working order for each performance.
- To perform the Video No 2 track for each performance.
- To keep Video reference/cue sheets up to date.
- To liaise with the Company Stage Manager/Resident Artistic staff regarding daily cast changes and prepare the video equipment changes accordingly.
- Attend rehearsal, technical, dress and understudy rehearsals as required.
- Deal with emergency repairs and fixes to video equipment and programmes.
- Recognise where maintenance work needs to be carried out/replacements are required for non-consumable and rented equipment to bring this to the attention of the Video No1 so this may be scheduled to ensure no show delays.
- Ensure that work materials and video equipment is kept in a tidy and secured manner.
- Ensure that security, safety and good housekeeping procedures for the department are properly carried out.
- Comply with the Manager's Health and Safety and other policies at all times.
